

**Special November Town Board Meeting Meeting
November 5, 2025
Public Hearing 2026 Greig Town Budget**

Meeting called Public Hearing to order at 5:35 P.M.. Supervisor Johnson led Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Roll Call: Councilmen Olmstead, Mallette, and Mayhew are present. Also Town Clerk Gunn and North Country CPA's Emily and Franz Philippe

Councilman Bailey-Swisher was absent

No Members of the Public were in attendance.

Supervisor Johnson indicated a few items were discovered after the Preliminary Budget was accepted at the last meeting. Funds were moved from 2025 Balance Forward to the DA Fund to make the burden on taxes less. We were going to place \$7500 into a Fund for Truck Purchase. It makes more sense to place it into the 2026 DA Expense budget. The amount for the 3G Fire Department was less than they requested, so the amount was increased from \$71000 to \$71147. The North Country CPA's budgeted amount will be reduced to \$18000 from the original \$21000.

Supervisor Johnson closed the Public Hearing at 5:50PM

Special November 5th Meeting called to order at 5:51PM

Approve the changes, just discussed by Supervisor Johnson, making the Budget on the table the Town of Greig Final Budget for 2026.

Councilman Olmstead reported on a meeting he had with Brantingham Lake Dam Control Attendant Mr. Scott Hunt and Civil Engineer Mr. Steve Thesier at the Brantingham Lake Dam site. They are working on a plan that has been proposed by Mr. Rudy Zona for the repair to the Dam. It was observed that the dam will require both a control box and a new gate. The proposed changes were estimated to be \$10,000, but the additional work will add between five to ten thousand more to the project. The town now has \$20,000 in a fund for the work. The design team will work on a solution and that should be completed by the end of November.
